The Early Childhood Learning Center celebrates and welcomes diversity.

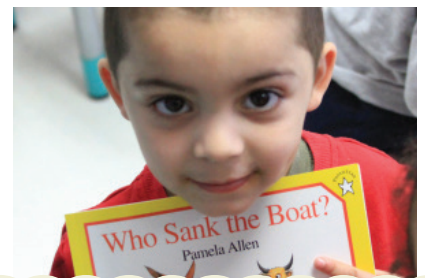

The center is open year-round from 7:30 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. and offers two options to parents:

- Schedule 1: 7:30a.m. to 5:30p.m. For children of parent(s)/guardian(s) **who are working or attending school full time.**
- Schedule 2: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. For children of parent(s)/guardian(s) **who are not working or attending school full time.**

* Minimum entrance age is 3 years old with the exception of children who are 2 years 9 months old during the months of September - December of any given year, turning 3 years old by December 31st of that year.

**Child must be toilet trained upon entry into the program.
